Transforming Learning Experiences in Assam

In March 2026, the eVidyaloka CEO and team, along with a Field Coordinator from NEAID, visited two Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalayas (KGBVs) in Assam—Juria (Nagaon) and Lahorighat (Morigaon)—to review the progress of the EmpowerED program in its second year and understand its on-ground impact.

During the interactions, the team engaged with government officials, school leaders, teachers, and students to assess implementation and gather feedback. Stakeholders appreciated how the program complements the school curriculum by strengthening life skills, communication abilities, and digital exposure. The inclusion of cyber security awareness and ethical use of AI modules was also well received.



Wardens and teachers observed improvements in students' confidence, participation, digital literacy, and career awareness. Students also shared their experiences of engaging in interactive sessions and exploring learning beyond textbooks. Overall, the program continues to create a positive impact by fostering a more engaging and future-ready learning environment, with discussions focused on expanding and strengthening such interventions for long-term growth.

A display of the eVidyaloka poster at their office marks a meaningful step towards building stronger community connections and expanding the network of Gujarati-speaking volunteers.



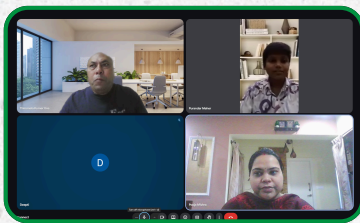
Assessment Progress Across States

Overall, the assessment is progressing steadily across states, reflecting strong coordination and commitment from schools and stakeholders.



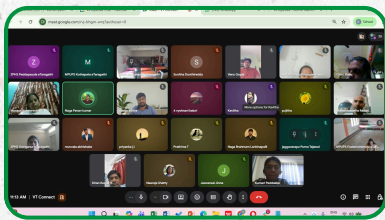
Mentorship for Learning and Development

Volunteer Connect: Sharing Insights and Experiences

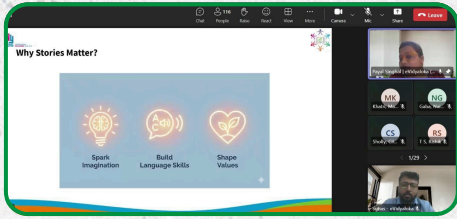

Content Creation Drives with Corporate Partners

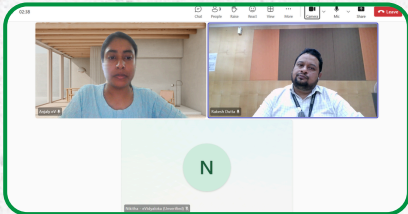

From Classroom to Confidence: An NSIC Finalist's Journey



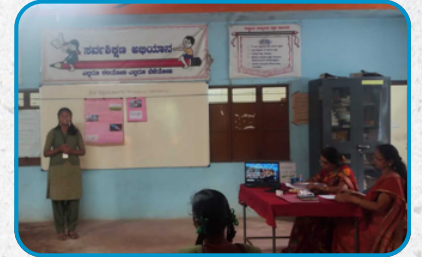
