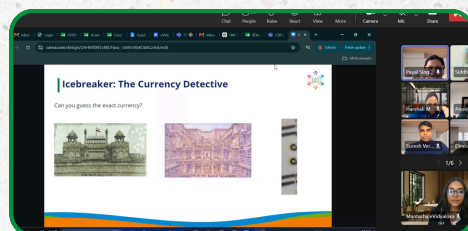
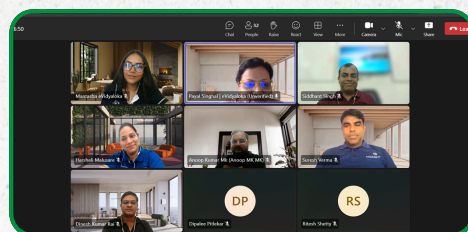

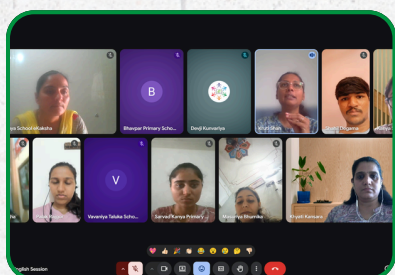
Content Creation Orientation with Assurant

The session encouraged active participation and curiosity, demonstrating how learning can be both meaningful and engaging while helping students build confidence and real-world awareness.

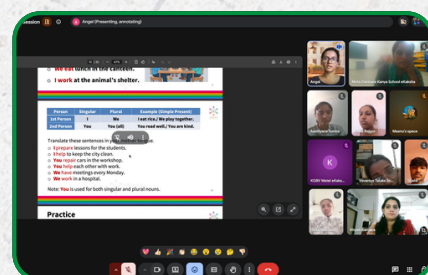


Spoken English Training Sessions for Gujarat Class Assistants
