With a vision to create a knowledgeable and empowered rural India, eVidyaloka has become an aspiration in transforming the educational landscape, by setting up digital classrooms in remote and rural villages and connecting them with passionate volunteers from across the globe.

Our core objectives at the start of the year was to draw a robust volunteer mobilisation mechanism and sustain operation measures while strengthening the organisation.

This AY 19-20, we are operational in 237 centres across 10 states in India and we started the year with more than 80% of last year's volunteer teachers expressing their intent to continue into AY 19-20. Over the year, we have engaged 1700+ volunteer teachers.







## Delivery Partners



The Partner Organisations (P.O.) are identified and engaged based on a robust diligence procedure. Based at the grassroots, they play a key role in identifying potential schools, setting up the Digital Classrooms after seeking prior approval from the local government, and also maintaining the classroom in the respective village-schools. The P.O. also works in tandem with the school administration, the local community (including parents), internet service providers and other vendors to ensure smooth delivery of classes at the Centre. A synergy between the local NGOs and the governing bodies leverages a well-established trust and relationship that makes the eVidyaloka initiative sustainable at the field level. Local NGO partners take consent from local SDMCs (School Development and Monitoring Committee) or an equivalent body, and the BEO (Block Education Officer) for operating the Digital Classroom in government schools that are located in remote, rural villages. This bottom-up approach helps to build value-acceptance amongst the beneficiaries and to drive sustainability and accountability.



## Class Delivery Summary






## Diagnostic Outcome



Diagnostic test is a baseline test which is very important for any new eVidyaloka center, to assess the capability of the students.

This helps the Volunteer Teachers who start to teach at the center to understand the basic levels of their students and plan their lesson plans accordingly.

Thereby, encouraging them to develop their interpersonal skills and provide them with the necessary support for their higher education.




## Scholastic Outcome



At eVidyaloka, we strive to ensure that children continue to understand and learn from their sessions. We have two assessments conducted – Term 1 and End-term assessments. This not only evaluates the students but also the volunteer teachers. Thereby assuring impact-driven development across the year.

Over the years, we have seen an improvement in the learning levels of students. There is a clear trend in the improvement of their learning levels. This year's average score was affected as we couldn't complete end-term assessments across 3 states.





**Leadership Curriculum** is a three month program that has been inducted into eVidyaloka's Digital Classroom Programmes. An opportunity to open different paths and possibilities to students that show an extra spark in the classroom and are inquisitive about learning more. The program is about setting small goals based on SMART goals and working towards achieving them. After which, students will give a TED-style talk on the chosen goal. In the past, we have seen that the children emerge confident and exhibit leadership qualities as they get into deciding their goals and working towards achieving them. They are given an opportunity and platform for an audience to witness their talk. This helps them to get into a process of learning and applying the same towards any and all future goals. This was the third year of the LC program. We had 137 students participate. There were a total of 28 mentors. The program was conducted in 28 centres among 7 states. A jury panel of 7 people was formed and the evaluation was done zone wise. The jury selected one student from each zone. The three zones were South Zone (Karnataka, Tamil Nadu & Andhra Pradesh), North Zone (Uttarakhand & Maharashtra) and East Zone (Jharkhand & West Bengal). All three students were given a chance to come to Bangalore during RUBARU 2020 to present their goals and for felicitation.

One significant segment of RUBARU has always been the National Student Innovation Challenge (NSIC). NSIC is about nurturing talent and leadership for Grade 6, 7 & 8 students. A unique Pan-India contest, the challenge comprises of teams of students from 2 students from urban (government or private. Schools) and 2 students from rural (eVidyaloka) schools from across India working together on projects. 350+ students from Rural Schools and 250+ students from Urban Schools across Tamil Nadu, Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh, Jharkhand, West Bengal, Maharashtra and Uttarakhand, came together for the National Student Innovation Challenge and were split into teams. Teams were given the opportunity to work on projects that address problems based on any one of the 17 UN Sustainable Goals, and come up with innovative solutions over Skype, Email and Whatsapp with the help of a Mentor.

A jury panel went through 45 submissions and selected 5 Winners and 5 Runner-ups. Post this, as a token of appreciation and in an effort to applaud the work of the winning teams, these children from the 5 winning teams (located in different states) were invited to Bangalore, to set-up an exhibition for their projects over the course of two days. A jury short-listed the live presentations of the 5 winning teams. These teams were scored on the basis of the innovation and impact the project has created. The top three scoring teams were felicitated as winners, and the remaining two teams were felicitated as finalists during the prizing distribution ceremony at RUBARU 2020.





On February 7, 2020, we had our annual event — RUBARU, powered by LTI. This event is a platform where we bring together all the pillars of our organisation - our volunteer teachers, donors, NGO partners and well-wishers. This year's theme 'Nurture & Educate the Aspiring New Young India' was in sync with the motivation and outcome of this year across our eVidyaloka centers and partners.

The event started with a patron's address by Prof. V. Krishnamurthy and followed with keynote addresses given by Shri S. P. Balasubrahmanyam and Sameer Garde, the President – Cisco India & SAARC. A short video was played by MP Tejasvi Surya.

The panel was moderated by Mr. Ramkumar Venkataraman, eVidyaloka's Board Member. The discussion was led by the following panel member - Mr. Mahesh Esthuri (AVP & Head, CSI Technology Office, LTI), Mr. Deepak Prabhu (Global Head, Employee Volunteering Program (Outreach), Cognizant), Mr. Raghavendra K (Senior VP and Global Head - Human Resources Development, Infosys BPM), Mr. Amit Doshi (Chief Marketing Officer (India and South Asia), Lenovo), Mr. Nirbhay Lumde (Director - Corporate Social Responsibility, Asia Pacific SBU, CG) and Mr. Abhishek Ranjan (Director - Sustainability, Brillio).

The Volunteer Champion Awardees, the V-Gnyana winners, the NSIC winners and the Leadership Curriculum winners were felicitated during the Prizing Ceremony. A final vote of thanks at the end of the event was delivered by Mr. Venkat Sriraman, eVidyaloka's cofounder and trustee.



## Pride of Place



Tamil Nadu's Semmambadi Center students participated in

This project was chosen as one of the best 100 projects, and the students were given medals, trophy and certificates by Mr. Mayilsamy Annadurai from ISRO.





Sandeep Sharma, a 7th standard student from Uttar Pradesh, won the National Level Appreciation Prize in the PCRA essay competition.

He was the only student from a government school to make it to the final round. He was gifted a certificate and a Samsung tablet.

Shiva Oraon, an 8th standard student from Jharkhand, is very fond of art. To enable this, he used the internet and digital classroom infrastructure to teach himself how to draw and paint. With his determination and support from his school and peers, he is constantly increasing his skill and able to explore different ways to bring his paintings to life.



## Community Engagement



Online Parent-Teacher Meetings: We noticed that in the government schools, there was a slight inertia from the parents to engage with the schools and to encourage their children to attend school. For students to be completely engaged with the program and to be motivated to continue their education once they finish 8th standard, we introduced the Parent-Teacher Meeting format. The aim here is to involve the community that surrounds our students. The parents are invited for PTMs at the centers and our Volunteer Teacher connects through skype. Many times, the headmaster or school teachers or even BEO attend these meetings and it always has a fruitful outcome.

The parents are taken through the importance of education, the implementation of this digital program and its benefits, and how parents should keep sending the children to school. The Volunteer teachers share insights and tips to encouraging children and giving them the chance to practice their learnings. The children are also given a platform to present something they've learnt in class to their parents like an English recital or a project that they made. We have had approximately 85 PTMs this year which involved around 116 volunteer teachers and more than 250 parents

In Uttarakhand, English-medium science textbooks were introduced in 6th standard. The children struggled to comprehend the subject as a result. The schoolteachers asked for help on this. The English and Science volunteer teachers from each center, were connected on a call. Together they came up with a strategy wherein the English volunteer teachers would take up reading sessions from the science textbooks as a separate exercise. This has helped the children to perform better in their assessments.



### Volunteers Stepping Up



Volunteer Teacher Ishrat Sheikh hails from Switzerland. She took time out to understand the general needs in the village in Maharashtra. After finding out that electricity is a major problem that affects, she made a move to educate and empower the children to help themselves. She connected with IIT Bombay for their solar initiative. IIT Bombay organized a Student Solar Ambassador 2019 workshop on October 2, 2019, in Sarola Kasar. The first time a workshop of this magnitude was conducted in the rural area. The aim of the workshop was to not only promote solar energy, but also to develop job opportunities.to local youth and housewives by training 60 of them in installing solar lamp and in promoting sustainability. Around 230 students from 3 different centers in MH participated. 1500 other students around Ahmednagar were also guided by Volunteer Teacher Nagesh to prepare solar kits.

Currently the CA is working with the students to help them grasp basic computer skills. Once they have mastered this, Aakrati and her friends will begin taking coding classes with them.

Aakrati's goal is to provide this skill across all the centers as she truly believes in the cause.

He conducted a robotics workshop where students drew robotic designs and instructed them how to build robots out of the equipment and that they had carried with them.

The students thoroughly enjoyed the session and were exposed to a new avenue for their education and career prospects.

Amrutha Prasad is a volunteer teacher who has made a great impression on her students from Hanumakoppa Center in Karnataka. Once this academic year began, the students that had passed out from the previous year visited the school just to inform her that they were continuing their education and have taken admission in a nearby high school. An emotional moment for this volunteer teacher and led her to making a visit to the center and conducted a PTM in person later on.



### **VMeet**

As we built up our network of online volunteer teachers and reached a count of 1,792+ this year, we went offline with them. We conducted regional VMeets across the year to engage and connect with our volunteer teachers and create a peer group amongst them.

Talking points were not just restricted to sharing tips and suggestions on teaching methods. They included feedback on how the classes can be utilised better and become more productive. Outcomes from these sessions involve collecting different perspectives and learnings to implement into the program. This year our VMeets were conducted in Bangalore, Mumbai, Delhi, Chennai, Hyderabad, Vizag, San Jose and London.
















## Global eVeans Day




